

t has often been asked whether Divine Love is realised and practised on the dual plane or on the non-dual plane. It is a mistaken belief that Love acts merely on the dual

God is infinite Love. It is not that we are to love God, but we have to realise God as Love. This Love is the fundamental attribute of the all-pervading Atman who is our real being and existence. The moment we have realised that we are this Truth, our vision is universalised and we feel our identity with all creatures, beings and things of this globe. ight from the beginning, while I could understand and accept the role played by Papa's (God's) Love as Creator and Protector, I could never bring myself to understand



how the same Universal Love which created and protected could also destroy. Over this, when I sat before Papa in the early days, mentally I used to ask him a lot of questions to make me understand how Love could play a 'destructive' role, as I looked at it.

Then, Papa (God) enabled me to reach the fifth Chakra (through deep inward journey) and, thereafter, I began to experience — all due to His Love only — increasingly a state of emptiness all around me and within me. Everything seemed to vanish into Nothingness and I felt the kind of Void that you see when you go outside and look up at the sky. Then, He made me understand what the so-called destruction meant. It was no contradiction of His Love at all. It was nothing but the dissolution of everything into Nothingness, that is, return to Papa's (God's) true state, which meant all Void.  $\square$

## PUJYA SWAMI MUKTANANDAJI'S VISIT TO CHENNAI

s willed by Beloved Papa, Pujya Swamiji visited Chennai from the 28th of September to the 3rd of October. During his sojourn, a 3-day spiritual retreat was held at Prem Nagar, Padappai. Some of the points covered in the sessions were as follows:

- **Ideal of the Ashram:** The sessions started with an in-depth study on the words of Beloved Papa on the ideal of the Ashram, which is: 'Universal Love and Service based upon a vision of Divinity in all beings and creatures.' There emerged four points during the study:
  - **1. Vision of Divinity:** It means identifying the Common Factor our Origin in all of us. In this context, the following words of Beloved Papa will help us start our journey of identifying the Common Factor: "Try to enter into the mysterious origin of your and the world-life. To know who you are in reality is the real quest..."

**The Origin:** When an effort is made to move along in this direction, we realise that although initially we thought that our parents were our origin, we can soon infer that they were merely the instrumental causes because they were also

born to their parents, who were, in turn, born to their own parents, and so on. At best, we may be able to trace back a few generations, but not all the way to the First Cause / Origin. Now our efforts turn to getting to know the Origin from which everything has sprouted, including us. When the intellect pleads its inability to find the First Cause, we can seek the answers from Srimad Bhagavad Gita, in which the Lord said, "Beejam Maam Sarva Bhutanam" (I am the Eternal Seed of everything).

The Great Provider: At the beginning, we do not have any clear-cut idea about God. He is not an entity. Hence, Beloved Papa defines Him as the Subtle and Mysterious Power. This Power is the seed, from which the present sense of individuality came into being. When we, in the form of a seed, were in our mother's womb, this Power enabled us to develop 200 and odd organs in 9½ months, which function in a well-coordinated manner.

When we came out into the world, we did not bring anything with us; the Power which gave us Life and the body, has been providing us with everything through Mother Nature: the air to breathe, the water to drink, the earth to exist, space to move about, 98.4-degree temperature to keep us alive; the sun, rains, metals, minerals, gases, vegetables, fruits, pulses. As we grow, our dependence on creature comforts also increases; none of them are made by us. Even the basic requirements — brush, paste, soap, wash basin, commode, dress, food, language, education, profession — have been provided by Him through the Primordial Intelligence expressing through His selected instruments who are a part of the Society. Now we realise that we are what we are because of the bounteous gifts given by Him through Mother Nature and Society. But, when we deal with men and matters, we do it from our 'me' and 'mine' level, oblivious of our original nature. Should we not remember our Origin and react based upon that? Constant remembrance of our Origin helps us see the Common Factor in as many creations as possible, facilitating the expansion from 'me' to 'we' and then from 'we' to 'Him', which in turn reduces the dominance of 'me' and 'mine'.

**2. Mutual love and service:** Ashram is a school where we come to learn Universal Love and Service. This is the place where every effort will be made to cultivate the spirit of mutual love and service, so that what is realised within

its walls may prove as an example for the right conduct of human life in the outside world.

- **3. The Lord is our help and guide:** We should endeavour to become aware that the sense of individuality, Mother Nature and Society exist because of Him only. Therefore, our reliance on God should be total, knowing that He alone is behind everything.
- **4. Home of love and bliss:** We should feel a sense of belongingness towards the Ashram. When we are at home, we will not find fault or complain even if something goes wrong; we will merely try to set right the situation in whatever manner possible.
- Triune Path: To facilitate this expansion, Beloved Papa has placed before us the triune path of Nama, Seva, Dhyana. Nama — to remember Him; Seva — to serve Him in all forms, animate and inanimate; and Dhyana to feel His presence within and then without.
- **Daily Routine In Ashram:** The programmes in Ashram, set by Pujya Mataji, serve as a reminder of the ideal of the Ashram and are a means to connect ourselves with it often. □

PUJYA SWAMI SATCHIDANANDAJI'S 15<sup>TH</sup> MAHASAMADHI DAY: This day, which was observed on the 12<sup>th</sup> of October 2023, reminded all of Pujya Swamiji's exhortation: "Human birth is a gateway to liberation; our True Being is our destination — our Real Home, our own Self; we go back as naked as we started from there."

Our life has not been initiated by us; it has been initiated by God. This fact is often forgotten. Therefore, we interact only from the 'me' and 'mine' level. Pujya Swamiji wanted us to return to our Real Home, which he emphasised could be achieved by approaching It in the spiritual nakedness of the soul. This means all of our preconceived notions, assumptions, rights and wrongs, likes and dislikes, etc. have to be given up.

What prevents us from approaching our Real Home is the sense of 'doership'; while the fact is that He gave us the sense of individuality to function as per His will. When we get stabilised in this truth, we will be moving towards our Real Home.



**PUJYA MATAJI KRISHNABAI'S 120**<sup>TH</sup> **JAYANTI:** This occasion, which was celebrated on the 14<sup>th</sup> of October 2023, was instrumental in making all deeply ponder over her following inspiring words: "All that Papa wants us to do is to transform whatever we say, do and think from first person into second person... What we have to do is dedicate all that we do with our mind, lips and hands to Him who is seated in our hearts and in the hearts of all, and who is still beyond everything."

This is not something we need to practise at a later date. We can start from this very moment. How should we do this? When we chant Ram Nam, we should know that He is making us chant. This could be one method of attributing our thoughts, words and deeds to the second person instead of the first person. This is a full-time Sadhana prescribed by Pujya Mataji in a simple, humble manner.
